Chateau de L'Aulee Intense Touraine Brut, Loire, France, NV 12.5%
Chapel Down Brut, Kent, England, NV 12.5%

Veuve Delaroy Brut, Champagne, France, NV 12%£57.00 This champagne has intense apple and circus fruit with a hint of cream biscuty flavours.
Veuve Delaroy Brut Rosé Champagne, France, NV 12%£62.00 It has fresh citrus aromas with yeasty layers. The palate is elegant with strawberry character and creaminess with a balanced acidity.
Veuve Clicqout Brut, Champagne, France, NV 12% Veuve Clicquot ages their non-vintage for almost twice the required time, resulting in a superb marriage of freshness and power with rich fruit and a mouth-filling mous.
Laurent Perrier Brut, Champagne, France, Millesime, 2004 12%£120.00 Fine & persistent bubbles. Very elegant, blending ripe fruit aromas with hints of creme brulee. Lingering crisp finish.

Dom Perignon Brut, Champagne, France, 2005 12.5%
Rosé Wines
Petit Papillion Grenache Rosé, Languedaoc-Roussillon, France, 2014 12.5%£24.00 Fresh and aromatic nose of raspberries and spices. This wine is lively and rich on the palate.
Ceppaiano Rosato, Tuscany, Italy, 2014 12%£29.00 Pink colour with purple notes. On the nose evident bouquet of fruit, peach, plum and apricot; on the palate
the freshness and sapidity are the characteristics of this easy drinking wine.
Delicato Family Vineyards White Zinfandel, California, USA, 2014 10%£35.00 This rose has intense aromas and flavours of ripe strawberries and cherries. It has a bright, refreshing finish.
Spy Valley Pinot Noir Rosé, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2015 13.5%£39.00 The aromas are of plum, peach and strawberry fruit notes. Refreshing and bright the balance is soft and

refined.



French White Wines

Jean Biecher Riesling, Alsace, France, 2015 12.5%£29.00
This dry wine displays great structure. It is characterized by intense freshness that can be appreciated from start to finish, whilst the mid-palate is defined by opulence and richness. The body is racy and delicately fruity.
Les Nuages Touraine Sauvignon Blanc, Loire, France, 2014 12%£31.00 Packed with punchy lime and gooseberry fruit.
Jacques Guindon, Muscadet Sur Lie Coteaux de la Loire, France, 2014 12%£32.00 Very fruity on the nose. Bright floral notes with lime and grapefruit. Crispy and very refreshing on the palate.
Bourgogne Aligote' Domaine Roux Per et fils, Burgundy, France, 2014 11.5%£33.00 This wine is made from Aligoté grapes and comes from the Burgundy region. It is a light wine with fresh ripe flavours of pear and citrus fruits.
Haut de Brun, Cotes du Rhone Blanc, Ajain Jaume & Fils, Rhone, France, 2014 13%£34.00 This wine is made from a blend of white local grape varieties including Grenache Blanc, Marsanne and Viognier. An elegant wine, it has floral aromas and flavours of citrus and peach.
Chateau Bonnet Blanc Reserve Entre-Deux-Mere, Bordeaux, France 2013 12%£34.00 A fresh delicate elegant nose that is very complex - lemon tarts, white flowers with a touch of flint stone. Fresh but rich and well balanced oozing notes of passion fruit, grapefruit and lemon.
Macon Ige Chateau London Domaine Fichet, Burgundy, France, 2014 13%£38.00 This wine has flavours of grapefruit and citrus fruit which twist towards white roses and acacia. A delicate yet full and creamy wine that is smooth in character.
Domaine Des Marroniers, Chablis, Burgundy, France, 2014 12.5%£43.00 Brilliant benchmark Chablis with clean, incisive Chardonnay fruit: green apples, hints of honey, lemon & limes, stony minerality and just a whisper of richness behind. No oak, just a pure Chablis style.
Sancerre Les Monts Damnes Domaine Andre Neveue, Loire, France, 2014 12.5%£49.00 A herbaceous, citrus nose with a hint of apple. Full and rich on the palate. Ripe fruit flavour with a zingy minerality and freshness.
Poully Fuisse', Domaine Robert-Denogent, Burgundy, France, 2013£55.00
A lemony nose with notes of honeysuckle. The palate is full of ripe pears with a zesty lemon note and a lick of minerality.
Chablis 1er Cru, Domiane Des Marranies, Burgundy, France, 2013£60.00
A classic, complex premier cru Chablis. This wine has aromas and flavours of citrus fruit intertwined with notes of gunflint.
Condreau, Lew Ravines, Robert Niero, Rhone, France, 2008
Puligny - Momtrachet, Roux Pere & Fils, Burgundy, France, 2012£80.00
A supremely elegant wine with rich flavour of ripe apple, lemon and tropical fruit with a hint of vanilla. It is a well-rounded, full bodied white with a long well balanced finish.



French Red Wines

Haut de Brun, Cotes du Rhone Rouge, Ajain Jaume & Fils, Rhone, France, 2014 14%£	.31.00
Beautiful deep red colour and an elegant fruity boeke of red berries and spicy present. The wine	has a
fine tannin structure and a sultry finish.	

Chateau De La Bouyere, Bordeaux, France, 2014 13% ________£30.00 The nose is powerful, complex aromas combining ripe black fruits and roasted savoury notes. The mouth is fleshy with a dense and tannic flavor which hints of red fruits and spices support the balance through the finish.

Broully Vielles, Vignes du Mouslin Favre, Burgundy, France, 2015 13%......£37.00 Light, juicy and fresh with lots of ripe strawberry and raspberry fruit and crisp acidity. The tannins are light and delicate with just enough power to carry the fruit along to the finish.

Paul Jaboulet Aine, Crozes Hermitage Rouge, Les Jablets, Rhone, France, 2013 13%.....£45.00 This wine is made from Syrah grapes. It is a rich wine with aromas of chocolate, baked dark fruits and pepper. The flavours are like red cherry and it leaves a very peppery after taste.

Reccomended Wine

Chateau Lamartre St-Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France, 2011 13.5%......£55.00 This is from the Bordeaux region of France, and red wines from here are usually called Claret. This wine is dry and medium-bodied, with flavours and aromas of spicy oak, black fruit and liquorice. It's mainly made from the Merlot grape variety.

Domaine Joseph Vilcot, Volnay 1er Cru, Les Fremiets, Burgundy, France, 2007.....£85.00Taking on some mushroomy development. The fruit is of the red persuasion and tinged with flora. Relatively simple and ready to drink.

Chatauneuf Du Pape, Chateau de Beaucastel, Rhone, France, 2009......£115.00
This vintage is very bright ruby in appearance a beautiful wine with power intense aromas of black fruit and chocolate. A vibrant wine with great balance.



Rest of Europe White Wines

Le Coste Trebbiano, Emilia Romagna, Italy, 2015 12%£24.00 Refreshing and light bodied with citrus flavours and delicate perfumed notes.
Conde Villar Vinho Verde Branco, Vinho Vende, Portugal, 2014 10.5%
La Maglia Rosa Pinot Grigio, Veneto, Italy, 2014 11.5%
Castillo Clavijo Rioja Barrel fermented, Rioja, Spain, 2013 12%£31.00 Barrel fermentation brings out exotic fruit, vanilla and clove flavours. It is rich and creamy but has managed to retain some great freshness.
Marotti Campi Verdicchio Dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Superiore, Marche, Italy, 2014 13.5%£32.00 This is a deliciously fresh, dry wine, perfect for a summer's day. It is delicately scented with more savoury almond and citrus flavours.
Gewurtztraminer Alois Lageder, Trentino Alto Adige, Italy, 2014 13.5%
Friendly Gruner-Veltliner Laurenz, Kanptal, Austria, 2013 12.5%£38.00 Resplendent in bright green fruit, this has a bewildering array of delicious flavours; peach, apple, pepper.
Morgassi Superiore Gavi di Gavi, Piedmont, Italy, 2014 12.5%

Reccomended Wine

Soave Classico Monte Carbonara Suavia, Veneto, Italy, 2013 13%......£45.00 Lightly floral on the nose this really jumps in to life on the palate: peach, flowers, apples and citrus with a very subtle creamy texture. Crisp and refreshing, but with real character, this is Soave at its very, very best.

Bogas Castro Martin, A20 Albarino Sobre Lias, Rias Baixas, Spain, 2014 12%.....£45.00 Smoky, earthy, leafy with bonfire aromas. Richer, riper style with an off-dry impression; yellow peaches, golden plums and exotic fruit, with lime acidity underpinning. Finish is long and ripe, with plenty of finesse and expression.

Bastianich, Vespa Bianco, Fruili, Italy, 2011.....£60.00
A tightly wound balance of minerality and citrus, clover honey and mature pear. This wine can be further aged up to 7-10 years after the vintage.



Rest of Europe Red Wines

Fico Grande Sangiovese, Emilia Romagna, Italy, 2014 12.5%£24.00 This is a soft and supple wine from Emilia-Romagna. It carries lovely red fruit characteristics and a hint of spice and pepper, followed by long, smooth tannins.
Solerana Barrel-Aged Tempranillo, Carinena, Spain, 2014 12.5%
Riva Leone Barbera, Piemonte, Italy, 2014 13.5%£27.00 Dark berry fruits with a core of fine tannins and the typical Barbera acidity.
Puklavec Family Heritage GOMILA Cabernet Merlot, Povardeire, Macedonia, 2013 13.5%
Castillo de Clavijo Rioja Crianza, Rioja, Spain, 2012 12.5%
Vallado Douro Red, Douro Valley, Portugal, 2013 13.5%£39.00 Very concentrated, with balsamic oak notes, red fruit and violet aromas. Sweet, round and matured and silky tannins, very balanced with a long fresh finish.
Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico, Nicolis, Veneto, Italy, 2009£70.00 This is a big rich wine with deep concentrated dried fruit, chocolate, spice and plum flavours. Ripe tannins and fresh acidity balance the intensity of flavour.
Barolo Castiglione, Vietti, Piedimont, Italy, 2011£90.00 Sweet red berries, freshly cut flowers, spices and mint are some of the many notes that grace the palate in a young Barolo with extraordinary finesse.
Rioja Gran Riserva Especial, Castillo Ygay, Rioja, Spain, 2005£90.00 Aromas of walnuts, dark fruit, ginger roasted seaweed, soya, iron, rosemary and lavender. Full bodied, yet polished and firm, the length is phenomenal.
Tignanello, Antinori, Tuscany, Italy, 2011£140.00 This wine is ripe on the nose with notes of dark fruits and an aromatic finish. Plum fruit dominate along with cherry and the aromas evolve with vigor and balance towards sensation of mint and liquorice. On the palate, though still young, the wine is ready and inviting.
Brunello Di Montalcino, Poggio All'oro, Banfi, Tuscany, Italy, Riserva 2006£150.00 A top quality wine with intense and powerful flavours of dark berry fruits, liquorice and subtle vanilla and floral notes. It is full bodied yet soft and velvety.



New World White Wines

Kleine Rust, Chenin Blanc and Sauvignon Blanc, Stellenrust, South Africa, 2015 13%£27.00 This wine is made from Chenin Blanc and Sauvignon Blanc, which is a popular white grape to grow in South Africa. It has lovely concentrated flavours of ripe melon, pear and guava with a fresh lime citrus finish.
Valdivisio Sauvignon Blanc, Valle Del Curico, Chile, 2015 12.5%£29.00 This is a crisp and aromatic Sauvignon Blanc with lots of citrus and gooseberry aromas. Crisp and refreshing with lemon and lime flavours together with a steely mineral quality.
Tilia Salta Torrontes, La Salta, Argentina, 2012 15.5%£30.00 Intense citrus and floral notes with a slightly bitter marmalade finish.
Tim Adams Foxlee Riesling, Clare Valley, Australia, 2012 12.5%£34.00 This is a dry wine made from Riesling grapes grown in the Clare Valley. The Clare Valley is regarded as one of the best places to grow Riesling in Australia. It is a vibrant and crisp wine with citrus aromas and lemon, lime and grapefruit flavours.
Satillite Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2015 13%£37.00 After picking and pressing the individual parcels were tank fermented. After fermentation the wines were aged on the yeast lees prior to blending and bottling.
Charles Smith Kung-Fu Girl Riesling, Washington State, USA, 2014 12%£38.00 This wine is from the Columbia Valley region of Washington state, two states up from California on the west coast of the USA. The grapes come from a cool site producing fruit with sublime minerality. The wine is smooth and aromatic with apricot, key lime and nectarine flavours.
Huia Pinot Gris, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2013 13.5%£43.00 This wine richly flavoured with a silky, creamy texture. Ripe pear and white peach flavours combine with a delicate touch of nuts and spice. It has excellent length and structure.
Morgan Montorey Sauvignon Blanc, California, USA, 2013 13.5% £45.00 Notes of lemongrass top a plethora of fruit characteristics. Namely pink grapefruit, nectarine, mango, passion fruit, lime and nutmeg aromas sit amongst a mineral touch. Refreshing acidity and a bright fruitful character complete with length.
Battle of Bosworth Chardonnay, McLaren Vale, Australia, 2012 13%£48.00 The grapes used to make this wine are organic which means no chemicals or pesticides were used in the growing process. Chardonnay is the grape variety that was used to make this wine. It has aromas and flavours of citrus fruit and crisp green apple.

Graham Beck The Game Reserve Merlot Coastal, Robertson, South Afica, 2014 14%£31. The Merlot grape variety makes wine which has rich, dark fruit flavours like plums and blackberries. Twine, in particular, is very fruity and is soft, smooth and easy-drinking.	
Esquina de Argento Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2014 14%	urs
The Colonial Estate Explorateur Shiraz, Barossa, Australia, 2015 14%£39. The Explorateur Shiraz offers sweet aromas of blackberries, white pepper, liquorice and graphite. Whe full-bodied, powerful and rich it also displays striking finesse and elegance from its aging in French O	nile
Gnarly Head Old Vine Zinfandel, California, USA, 2013 14.5%	to ion
Garage Wine CO Old Vine Cabernet Savuvignion, LOT #51, Maipo Valley, Chile, 2013 14%£63. The grapes are manually harvested and transferred to open-top fermenters. Pressing and punching do is all done by hand. The wine is then aged in oak barrels before bottling.	
Black Stallion Cabernet Sauvignon, California, USA, 2014 14.5%£65.0 Crammed with juicy dark berry flavours such as blackcurrant and cassis, this wine is full-bodied ovelvety.	
Catena Zapata, Atena Zapata, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2010	his
St Henry Shiraz, Penfolds, Multi Regions, Australia, 2012
