Our Favourites

Wines that are particularly good, great value for money and slightly unusual.

Vinho Verde 2013 Clip do Monte da Vaia - 31.00

Pedro Barbosa has taken over his parents' vineyard and there's plenty of character in this Vinho Verde. Bright and fresh with good intensity on the palate, with green apples, citrus peels and a mineral driven finish.

Friulano 2011 Ronc di Vivo, Colli Orientali - 33.00

Hints of spice and white pepper are followed by textured white peaches on the palate, and a lovely, concentrated core, amazing for such an inexpensive wine

Viognier VDP 2013 Domaine Rougie, Languedoc - 32.00

Very low yields for this quality oak-aged viognier with a characteristic apricot, peachy stamp. Almost a Condrieu at third of the price.

Muscadet Sur Lie 2013 Sébastien Chéreau - 34.00

There's nothing duller than a dull Muscadet and this is not it - it's about as perfect a Muscadet as you will find. It's crisp, clean and lemony with great body and concentration.

Nativo 2011 Hughes Family, Swartland, South Africa - 38.00

A really elegant, medium bodied and well-rounded blend of Viognier and Chenin Blanc. Fragrant aromas of pears and an underlying citrus flavours and a long fresh finish

Weißburgunder 2013 Bender, Mosel – 39.00

This fabulous Pinot Blanc makes you understand why German wines were so popular in the UK before they became politically difficult. Luscious, but with a crisp balance that just makes you want to drink more and more of it.

Godello, Louro 2014 Rafael Palcios, Valdeorras - 46.00

The Palacios family are Spain's best wine makers and they are famed for their wines made with the Godello grape. This is a fabulous example, complex, rich and luxurious with a fine acidity and lasting finish.

Pinot Bianco 2012 Doro Princic, Collio, Italy - 50.00

Alessandro Princic rarely feels the need to export, as he has regular queues of cars parked outside his winery, waiting to fill their boots

Meursault Limozin 2009 Alain Coche - 54.00

Elegant with notes of white peach & almonds on the nose that compliment the rich, generous fruit. Very fine.

Ramey Wine Cellars Chardonnay 2010 Russian River, California - 56.00

Really Great Chardonnay with stunning balance. Ripe fruit, cream, sweet spice and toast from 100% French oak

Riesling Grand Cru Muenchberg 2010 Domaine Andre Ostertag - 57.00

From a vineyard found by Cisterian Monks in the 12th Century. Powerful, full of energy and balance. A very special wine.

Condrieu 2012 Jean-Luc Colombo - 63.00

From the master of the Rhone a fantastic classic Condrieu. With the luscious depth of Viognier balanced by fresh acidity.

Drink only slightly chilled to get the best out of it.

Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru Folatières 2011 Jean Chartron - 72.00

A wonderfully mature drop of Puligny from one of the village's top estates - typical Chardonnay from this vineyard, all white flowers and minerality.

Zinfandel 2014 Lammershoek 'Craig Hawkins' - 26.00

Made by the new young breed of South African wine makers, this unpasturised Zinfandel defies expectations.

Light-bodied with bright red berry fruit flavour – easy-drinking and lots of fun!

Saint Nicolas de Bourgueil 'Les Rouillères' 2012, Frederic Mabileau - 37.00

Pretty nose of raspberry and fresh greenery. Fresh and round with ripe tannins and a characteristic note of graphite.

Vin de Pays d'Hérault 'Meli Melo' 2013 Domaine Roquemale - 38.00

This inspired discovery from a recent foray into the heart of the Languedoc is 100% Alicante, organic and relatively low in alcohol (11.7%). Think of it as a quaffable, sun-kissed Beaujolais of the South! - (Available Chilled)

Quinta de Val da Figueira 2007 Douro Portugal – 38.00

Intensity of Fruit, great balance a long and complex after-taste make this a really very good Douro.

Alsace Pinot Noir 2013 Ginglinger - Fix – 39.00

A really good Pinot Noir from a small Alsace producer – perfect for summer - great balance and depth

Faugères 2007 J.M & V Alquier - 44.00

From the best maker of Faugeres, this blend of Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre, Carignan, & Cinsault is complex, rich and velvety

<i>An expressive bouquet of raspberry, blackberry and incense. Broad, full-bodied with impressive depth and clarity.</i>			
56. Saperavi, Mukuzani, 2011 Shumi, Georgia			31.00
<i>100% Saperavi - aged in oak for 2 years - the classic Georgian grape variety. It gives off a characteristic blackberry aroma with a note of roasted coffee. Plenty of vivid cherry and Raspberry fruit and backed with gentle Tannins</i>

<i>A blend of Monastrell and Garnacha it has balsamic notes with body and structure. Elegant to the palate with an intense finish</i>			
59. St Chinian 2010 L'Ivresse des Cimes- Domaine des Terres Falmes			33.00
<i>Saint Chinian is one of the finest appellations of Languedoc, This is from 40 year old vines, & is minerally, spicy and tobaccoey.</i>			
60. Barbera d'Alba 2012 Tenuta Rocca			34.00
<i>Packed with spicy plum fruit, yet a subtle, under-lying acidity that makes it an ideal match for meats of all description.</i>

- 61. Brouilly 2013 Chateau des Tours** **38.00**
From one of the best producers this Brouilly is classic Gamay with body and acidity – also served chilled
- 62. Bourgogne Rouge, 2013 Le Clos, Mancia-Poncet** **9.50 28.50 40.00**
From the southernmost region of Burgundy, the Mâconnais, this is a very well made wine with delicious combination of red fruits, raspberry and strawberry flavours to the fore."
- 63. Château de Francs, 2007 Côtes de Francs** **40.00**
Wonderful drop of right bank claret – hardly surprising when the wine is made by the same team as at Saint-Emilion's Château Angélus
- 64. Kutyafaja 2012 St Andrea , Hungary** **41.00**
The blend of Kekfrankos, Merlot and Cabernet Franc gives this wine great subtlety and balance. Medium bodied with good fruit and acidity.
- 65. Crozes-Hermitage, 2012 Etienne Pochon** **42.00**
Seductive Syrah purity to this beautifully-crafted Northern Rhône, one would think it originated from a much smarter appellation
- 66. Malbec 2011 Pulenta Estate, Argentina** **43.00**
Classic sophisticated Malbec from Argentina. Ripe bramble fruit with sweet spice, ripe tannin with plenty of mouth feel
- 67. Pinot Noir 2013 Jules Taylor, Marlborough, New Zealand** **46.00**
Piercing, smoky Pinot, hints of blackberries and wild raspberries, with some soft tannins and acidity to balance
- 68. Massaya 2012 Bekaa Valley, Lebanon** **47.00**
From the makers of Vieux Telegraph in Chateaneu du Pape comes this top class wine. With Cinsault, Cabernet and Syrah this is gutsy and bold but with very good balance.
- 69. Château Campillot 2009 Médoc** **47.00**
One of the great vintages, and this petit château has produced an absolute classic claret, mainly Cabernet Sauvignon
- 70. Optima 2010 Anthonij Rupert, Western Cape, South Africa** **48.00**
An excellent Bordeaux-style Blend aged for 24 months in barrel Elegant and refined with silky ripe tannins, an integrated oak backbone and yet velvety smooth mouth-feel. Beautifully balanced. The after-taste lingers on.

Fine Wines

Top end wines and small parcels that we mark up very reasonably – some real bargains.

Chateau Grand Pey Lescours 2004 Grand Cru St Emillion - 53.00

Deep crimson in colour, just starting to reveal its age. A heady nose of red berry fruit & notes of coffee, followed by a palate of raspberries, red cherry and chocolate, supported by a good acidic structure and silky tannins.

Cote Rotie 'Champin Seigneur' 2009 Jean-Michel Gerin – 59.00

Warm spicy nose with some hints of medicine. The palate is savoury, spicy, meaty and has some red fruit character. Very fine with good complexity

Vosne-Romanée, 2006 Aurélien Verdet - 65.00

Quintessential Vosne, with elegant red fruits swathed in some soft tannins. This oozes classic Burgundian finesse

Napanook 2006 Christian Moueix Dominus Estae. Napa Valley – 67.00

The 2006 vintage - a blend of 87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc, 5% Petit Verdot and 3% Merlot. - is deep crimson in color. Its nose is dense, complex and full of black cherry, fresh almonds and bitter chocolate notes. The entry is very full and velvety, enveloped with round, deep tannins. The finish lingers on with aromas of bramble berries, cigar tobacco and cocoa beans.

Barolo Ginestra 2008 Paolo Conterno, Monforte d'Alba – 70.00

Considered by many to be one the finest vineyards in the entire Barolo appellation. Paolo Conterno creates masterpiece wines with dark colours, brooding tannins and incredible aromatics.
