Napoleon Cellar

In the 1840s, exiled to London, Louis Bonaparte plotted his return to power from our cellars. It is after this Napoleon that our Cellar, two floors below St James's Street, takes its name. Dating back to the early 19th century, the atmospheric space is perfectly suited to larger stand-up receptions and tastings, as well as sit-down lunches and dinners.
