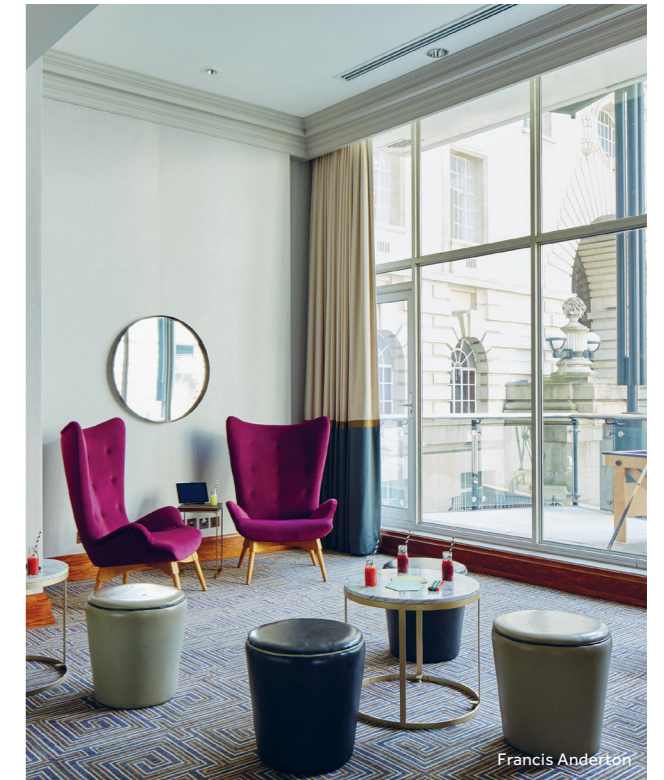


King George V

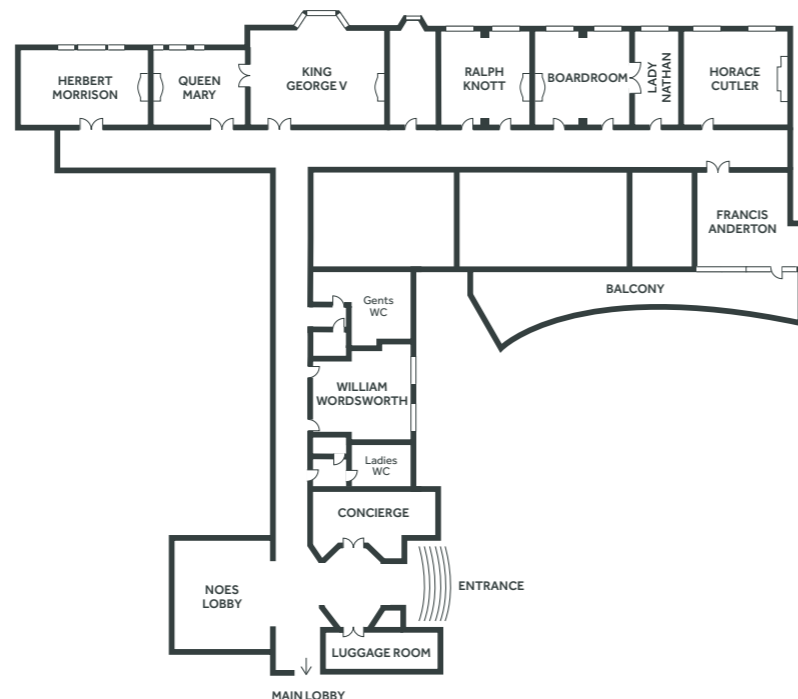

THE LIBRARY

Offering postcard-worthy views over Big Ben and the Houses of Parliament, The Library features oak bookcases stacked with the classics and busts of literary and historical figures like Shakespeare, Plato and Milton, which transport diners back to the 1920s.

First opened in 1922 by King George V and Queen Mary, The Library isn't without its own tale to tell. Struck by a bomb in World War II and the venue for many heated political battles between Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher and Ken Livingstone, the historic room houses a turbulent past – if walls could talk!
