# Champagne of the Month



Devaux is a dynamic Champagne house that specialises in Pinot Noir. Their style is dictated by their location in the sunnier southern part of the region, where Pinot Noir dominates and produces wines that are full, rich and expressive, without losing the finesse of classic Champagne. Devaux only use the initial lightly pressed juice (the *cuvée*) and age all their wines on their lees for at least three years (twice the minimum requirement), giving both complexity of flavour and an integrated fine mousse.
