LIGHTER TEXTURED AND AROMATIC

- 21 **Davy's White No.1** France 11.5% £5.10/£18.95
 This is an absolute favourite and rightly so. Honest and unpretentious, it brims with citrus and floral notes, with a crisp dry finish. Gentle pressing of the grapes helps to keep a fruity, aromatic style. A blend of Colombard, Ugni Blanc and just a touch of Sauvignon.
- 32 **Pellehaut Vin de Pays 2013** Côtes de Gascogne, France 11.5% £20.95
 Citrus and acacia flower deliciously balanced by a long lingering finish of exotic fruits on the palate. Traditional viticulture practices run by the Beraut family. An easy drinking blend of Southern French grape varieties.
- 36 **Picpoul de Pinet 2013 Berladent** France 13% £5.90/£21.95
 Bone dry and crisp palate displaying white flowers and peach. Sourced from the sun drenched vineyards of the Languedoc, a perfect accompaniment to most fish and white meat dishes.
- 24 **Davy's Pinot Grigio** Italy 12% £5.90/£21.95
 Crisp, clean, ripe fruit with nuances of aromatic spice and nuttiness. Sourced from the Veneto region, the wine is fermented at a low temperature to retain all the freshness and aromas of the fruit.
- 105 **High Altitude Torrentes/Chardonnay 2013** Mendoza, Argentina 13.5% £24.95
 Full of aromatic white fruits and flowers, with crisp, fresh notes, a touch of sweetness and a lingering finish. Made by Bodegas Escorihuela who, established in 1884, are the oldest winery in Mendoza.
- 37 **Le Versant Viognier 2013 Les Vignobles Foncalieu** France 12.5% £6.95/£25.95
 Lovely crisp acidity, hints of crystallized fruits and mouth-watering dried apricots and white peaches. Made in the Languedoc by Les Vignobles Foncalieu who have cutting-edge facilities and a forward thinking approach to wine making.
- 78 **Le Riesling Jean Becker 2010** Alsace, France 12.5% £7.40/£27.75
 A winemaking legacy dating back to 1610 and now in the hands of the 13th generation. Certified organic this Riesling shows lemon sherbet, lime and pink grapefruit; crisp and clean with a lengthy finish. Davy's have sole UK distribution.

MEDIUM BODIED AND FLAVOURSOME

- 20 **Condorito Chardonnay 2013** Central Valley, Chile 12% £4.80/£17.95
 Tropical notes of mango and papaya dominate with a hint of honey, vanilla and toast. Chile is recognised as producing some of the highest quality entry level wines on the market.
- 122 **Grillo Baglio Gibellina 2013** Sicily, Italy 12% £6.00/£22.50
 An indigenous varietal of Sicily, Grillo thrives in the hot and dry climate of the island. 100% steel fermentation to maintain freshness. Abundantly aromatic with lush notes of apricot, lemons and herbs with an underlying minerality.
- 9 **Signal Cannon Chenin Blanc 2013** Paarl, South Africa 12.5% £22.95
 Packed with ripe, plump, exotic fruit flavours. The palate is surprisingly full for an unoaked wine. Chenin Blanc is South Africa's signature white grape variety and capable, with low yields, of making wines with real individuality.

WHITE WINE CONTINUED

- 35 **Ventisquero Sauvignon Blanc Reserva 2013** Casablanca, Chile 12.5% £6.30/£23.50
Beautiful aromas of citrus fruits and spring blossom, balanced by a crisp and clean finish. This selection from Ventisquero is indicative of the great things being accomplished in Chile with Sauvignon Blanc.
- 28 **Davy's Sauvignon** Bordeaux, France 12% £23.95
Lovely full flavoured wine packed with crunchy citrus and stone fruits, balanced perfectly with acidity and mineral notes. An excellent example of a refreshing Sauvignon Blanc from the Bordeaux region.
- 174 **Mount Brown Riesling 2011** Waipara, New Zealand 13.5% £25.95
Classic lemon, lime and apple with a slightly off-dry finish. Waipara's limestone hillsides combined with a long hot Autumn helped produce a uniquely richer, spicy style. Davy's are the sole distributors in the UK.
- 33 **Ardèche Chardonnay 2013 Louis Latour** France 13% £25.95
Unoaked with fresh apple, crisp acidity and a smooth finish. Although Louis Latour is one of the most highly-respected producers in Burgundy this is from vineyards closer to the Rhône where the family planted grapes in the 1970's. It is now their best selling wine.
- 34 **Mount Brown Sauvignon 2013** Waipara, New Zealand 12.5% £7.65/£28.50
Katherine Keith, whose family own Mount Brown, used to visit our wine merchants in Greenwich. Ever since we tasted her wine in 2010 we have been sole distributors in the UK. Bursting with passionfruit and pineapple with an underlying citrus minerality.
- 142 **Arcan Albarino 2011/12** Rias Baixas, Spain 12% £29.50
Exclusive to Davy's sourced from a two hectare site overlooking the ocean. White flower nose with citrus, pear and nectarine. No oak, with six months on the lees for added depth and complexity.
- 143 **Gavi di Gavi Tonino Deltetto 2013** Italy 12.5% £33.50
Lime and zesty grapefruit with a lengthy finish. Antonio Deltetto's Gavi shows the Cortese grape as it once was before its rampant commercialization: full of life, fresh fruit, dry and perfectly balanced.
- 39 **Sancerre Cuvée les Moulins Bâles 2013 Léon Vatan** Loire, France 12.5% £34.95
Characteristically restrained rather than exuberant, perfumed with citrus and chalk rather than bold fruit. Enticing fruit on the palate, well balanced with a crisp, zingy gooseberry finish.
- 51 **Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2013** Marlborough, New Zealand 13.5% £41.95
Vibrant aromatics infuse with tropical fragrance of passionfruit and juicy pineapple. The ripe fruit is complemented by crisp natural acidity. Cloudy Bay have been setting the benchmark for Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc since 1985 – often imitated, rarely bettered.

FULLER BODIED AND RICH

- 25 **Davy's White Burgundy** France 13% £7.20/£26.95
Sourced from Roche Vineuse in the Mâconnais this family owned winery is dedicated to minimum intervention and low yields. Harvested late to give added intensity and ripeness with lower acidity. Un-oaked Chardonnay with ripe fruits, hints of butter and nuttiness.
- 172 **Sidewood Estate Chardonnay 2012** Adelaide Hills, South Australia 14% £27.95
Handpicked parcels from the cool climate area of Adelaide Hills. Intense flavours of nectarine, crisp green apple and nuances of butterscotch and vanilla evolving from 6 months maturation in French Oak.

- 26 **Chablis ac Domaine d'Elise 2013** France 12.5% £8.30/£31.00
 This pocket sized Domaine lies just above the Premier Cru vineyards of Cote de Lechet. Classic style Chablis, lime and peach flavours dominate, balanced by flinty minerality.
- 58 **Rully La Chaponniere 2012 P & L Borgeot** France 13% £34.50
 All the class and pedigree of many wines offered by northerly region Beaune. If all Rully producers made wine like this, prices would surely rise. Stunning vintage, superb richness and weight on the body with honeysuckle, lemon and quince.
- 30 **Wattle Creek Chardonnay 2011** Yorkville Highlands, California 14% £35.00
 We are the sole distributors in the UK of this boutique Estate grown wine. Burgundian elegance with rich tropical mango and melon aromas layered with cream and toasty French oak. Lemon curd and citrus on the palate.
- 125 **Little Beauty Gewurztraminer 2010** Marlborough, New Zealand, 13.5% £35.95
 Ex Cloudy Bay wine maker at this bespoke independent winery only uses the best French oak from select Burgundian coopers. Only 600 cases made. Off dry, a heady nose, beautifully perfumed. Jasmine, rose petal, orange, smoke and spice.
- 56 **Chablis 1er Cru Vau de Vey 2013 Domaine Malandes** France 12.5% £39.95
 Racy freshness with nutty hints and elegant length. The 1er Cru pedigree of Vau de Vey shines through in the classic mineral character of this wine, with just a hint of oak a hallmark of the Domaine.
- 23 **Meursault Village 2010 Domaine Michelot** France 13% £49.95
 Producing wine for six generations this Domaine is meticulous in its winemaking, displaying the finest characteristics of Meursault. Elegant and complex with a perfect balance of underlying richness. Honey and nuts with a vibrant and snappy citrus finish.
- 40 **Puligny Montrachet Village 2011 Jean Pascal** France 13.5% £59.00
 Rich, elegant with crisp lemon acidity. Aromas of apricot, peach and acacia flower. This small family Domaine embodies meticulous traditional winemaking with minimal use of oak.
- 108 **Condrieu Vin Rare 2011/12 Dauvergne Ranvier** Rhône, France 13% £59.00
 100% Viognier. Superb balance, elegant yet powerful, white flowers, peach and almond. Made up of a myriad of small vineyards which are difficult to access, the Condrieu appellation produces arguably the best Viognier in the world.
- 53 **Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Champs Gain 2006 Jean-Noël Gagnard** France 13.5% £65.00
 Aged for 18 months in oak barrels (one third new oak) the concentrated fruit is perfectly balanced by light butterscotch and toasty notes. This is a classically structured wine crafted by winemaker and daughter of Monsieur Gagnard, Caroline Estimee.

Rosé Wine

- 48 **Pinot Grigio Rosato 2013** Italy 12.5% £5.35/£19.95
Pale coloured Rosé. Sourced from Veneto, crisp and clean with soft fruity notes, aromatic spice and a touch of nuttiness.
- 178 **Saint Sidoine 2013 Rosé** Côtes de Provence, France 13.5% £24.75
Salmon pink, delicate style, with floral notes, strawberry and honeysuckle. Combining tradition with a modern approach, the family have been producing wine since 1923.
- 180 **Petit Rosé Tout Simple 2013 Ch Leoube** Provence, France 12.5% £29.95
Made by the Ott family, former winemakers and owners of legendary Provence estate Domaine Ott. Delicate and dry with aromas of peach and wild red berries on the palate. 40% Grenache, 40% Cinsault and 20% Mourvèdre.
- 46 **Sancerre Rosé Les Villots 2012 Léon Vatan** Loire, France 12.5% £33.50
Delicate salmon pink colour with clean refreshing honeyed Pinot Noir fruit. Sancerre Rosé is light to medium bodied, mineral with floral aromas and delicate flavours.

Red Wine

LIGHTER TEXTURED AND FRUITY

- 100 **Davy's Red No.1** France 12.5% £5.10/£18.95
A beautifully textured wine, with juicy raspberry and cherry. The predominant use of Gamay, blended with Grenache and Syrah, gives additional body and weight to the wine. This really is our number one.
- 110 **Sangiovese Armigero Riserva 2011** Italy, 13% £5.60/£21.00
Sangiovese is the king of Italian grape varieties, known for producing Tuscan greats such as Chianti and Brunello di Montalcino. This comes from Emilia Romagna and is slightly lower in acidity with sweeter tannins. Juicy black cherries, dried fruits and spice.
- 85 **Signal Cannon Merlot 2013** Paarl South Africa 14% £6.15/£22.95
Ripe red plums and blackberry with a hint of spice from the oak. Vondeling's winemaking history goes back more than 300 years, but was brought up to date with heavy investment by the Hampshire born winemaker in 2001.
- 83 **Brouilly Les Thibaults 2013 Jean Loron** Beaujolais, France 12.5% £25.95
Covering the largest area of the 10 Beaujolais Crus this offers an abundance of raspberry and red fruit aromas. Produced by Jean Loron, a family-run estate founded at the beginning of the 18th Century.
- 75 **Davy's Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Voarick Estate** France 12.5% £7.35/£27.50
This excellent light-medium bodied Bourgogne Rouge has lovely rich ripe Pinot Noir fruit of raspberry, cherry and strawberry, light tannins with a soft lingering finish. The reliable Voarick Estate has one of the largest vineyards in Burgundy.
- 88 **Domaine Valmoissine Pinot Noir 2011 Louis Latour** France 13.5% £27.95
This well made Pinot Noir is made in the Cotes du Verdon region in South East France by one of Burgundies best known producers. Silky flavours of plum, blackcurrant and spice.
- 116 **Barbera d'Alba 2012 Arpatin** Piedmont, Italy 14.5% £28.50
Full and fruity with flavours of blackberry, plum, cinnamon and pepper. The aromatic Barbera is the everyday drinking wine of choice on the wondrous Piemontese tables.

- 171 **Bourgogne Rouge 2010 Paul Pillot** Burgundy, France 12.5% £35.00
 Classic raspberry and cherry fruits with savoury and white pepper spice. Great depth and balance, real pedigree here. The wines from the excellent Chassagne based Domaine of Pillot express the terroir beautifully.

MEDIUM BODIED AND FLAVOURSOME

- 87 **Viña Temprana 2012** Campo de Borja Spain 13% £4.80/£17.95
 Rich and soft, flavours of wild red berries with earthy notes. From selected parcels of vines more than 40 years old, a blend of 50% Tempranillo and 50% Garnacha from the Aragon region, just south of Navarra and Rioja in Northern Spain.
- 165 **Ramirana Cabernet Sauvignon 2012** Maipo Valley, Chile 13.5% £6.00/£22.50
 Sourced from the cool climate Maipo Valley. Aromas of red cherry and cassis are supplemented by elegant notes of vanilla and chocolate imparted by 10 months French oak barrel-aging.
- 73 **Davy's Rioja Crianza** Spain 14% £6.70/£24.95
 Powerful layers of black and red fruits, deep in minerality, with gentle oaky vanilla notes at the finish. 75% Tempranillo, 25% Garnacha. Wines from each plot of vineyards are aged for one year in five year old American oak barrels, and then a minimum further one year in bottle.
- 84 **Ventisquero Reserva Pinot Noir 2012/13** Casablanca, Chile 13.5% £24.95
 Cherry and strawberry with vanilla and hints of buttery toast. Lovely finish with soft tannins. Ventisquero is led by a young, creative team of entrepreneurs whose aim is to create distinctive, high quality wines.
- 101 **Davy's Claret** Bordeaux Superieur, France 14% £7.50/£27.95
 Sourced from the Entre Deux Mers region in Southern Bordeaux. 63% Merlot, 32% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc. Complex and elegant with a mixture of black fruits and subtle oak. An easier style fruit driven Claret.
- 96 **Vierkoppes Cabernet Sauvignon 2010** Robertson, South Africa 13.5% £29.95
 English owner David Briscoe planted his very first vines in Hertfordshire in 2004. Just three years later he bought a small farm in the beautiful Breede Valley. 12 months in new French oak, full-bodied and smooth with flavours of cranberry, ripe cherry and vanilla.
- 141 **L'Ecuyer du Moulin Rouge 2010** Haut-Médoc Bordeaux 13.5% £31.00
 Classic left bank Claret soft and fruit driven with plum, tobacco and earthy notes. Located in the commune of Cussac Fort Médoc, great terroir between the prestigious appellations of Margaux and Saint-Julien-Beychevelle. Davy's are the sole UK distributors.
- 80 **Mount Brown Pinot Noir 2010** Waipara Valley, New Zealand 13% £33.95
 This oozes fresh raspberry and cherry whilst retaining a lovely savoury edge. Waipara is one of the unsung heroes of wine regions and fast becoming renowned for producing premium wines. Another Davy exclusivity.
- 47 **Château Tour St Bonnet 2009 Cru Bourgeois** Médoc Bordeaux 14% £36.00
 Intense blackberry with hints of liquorice, cedar and plum. 45% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot, 5% Malbec and 5% Petit Verdot. Château Tour St. Bonnet is a renowned cru bourgeois estate situated in the commune of St-Christoly in the far north of the Médoc.
- 173 **Maranges 1er Cru Les Fussieries 2009 Bachelet-Monnot** Burgundy 13.5% £39.95
 Earthy, ripe red berries, plum and pepper. Concentrated, round and plump. The Bachelet brothers make wines that are classically styled, emphasizing the inherent freshness, complexity and minerality in each cuvée. Wonderful Pinot Noir.

RED WINE CONTINUED

- 94 **Château d'Angludet 2008** Cru Bourgeois Supérieur, Margaux Bordeaux 13% £45.00
One of the stars of this underrated vintage. It is full of bright, defined red fruit character. A medium-full palate with rich ripe plums and raspberries, a touch of citrus peel finished off with cinnamon and clove spice.
- 155 **Château Cantemerle 2008** 5eme Cru Classe, Haut-Médoc Bordeaux 13% £52.00
One of the oldest properties in Bordeaux consistently producing good value elegant wines. Sweet tobacco, cherries, cassis and earthy notes. Medium bodied with gentle ripe tannins.
- 109 **Château Lagrange 2007** 3eme Cru Classe, Saint-Julien Bordeaux 13% £70.00
Creamy vanilla, sweet blackberry and crumble pastry. Ripe tannins and firm acidity. Saint-Julien is recognised to be the most consistent of the Médoc communes, with the highest concentration of 'Classed growths'.
- 97 **Beaune 1er Cru Grèves Vigne de L'Enfant Jesus 2005** Bouchard, Burgundy 13.5% £100.00
Intense and full with firm tannins, this Pinot Noir coats the palate with luscious wild berry fruit and toasty oak. Lovely tangy, complex Beaune with a weightless quality and a subtle emerging note of leather.
- FULLER BODIED AND RICH**
- 86 **Beyond the River Shiraz** Swan Hill Victoria, Australia 14% £18.95
Smooth ripe black fruits with a hint of pepper spice. Skilled winemaking, combined with attentive vineyard practices has produced a full-bodied, yet soft and fruity wine.
- 166 **Nero d'Avola 2012 Caleo** Sicily, Italy 13% £21.00
Nero d'Avola is one of Sicily's most important red grape varieties and is indigenous to Italy. Rounded, warm and full bodied, similar in style to New World Shiraz with sweet tannins, plum and spice flavours.
- 124 **Ventisquero Carménère Reserva 2012** Maipo, Chile, 13.5% £24.50
The 'lost' grape of Bordeaux has found its home in Chile and is now their signature variety. Deep and satisfying, with ripe bramble fruit flavours, a great alternative for Merlot fans that want something similar with added complexity and spice.
- 81 **Côtes du Luberon 2012 Dauvergne Ranvier** Rhône, France 13% £24.95
Classic Southern Rhône blend of Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre and Cinsault. Soft, smooth and smoky with notes of olive and black fruit.
- 113 **Altano Organic 2012 Symington Estate** Douro Valley, Portugal 13.5% £7.10/£26.50
Certified Organic in 2006 from renowned Symington Estates (of Graham, Dow and Warre fame). This has powerful Port-like aromas of blueberry and rose petals on the nose, while the palate delivers a rich, warm body of dark loganberry fruit.
- 76 **Finca Las Moras Reserva Malbec 2012** San Juan, Argentina 14% £7.50/£27.95
Grown at high altitude, 900 metres above sea level. Chunky and full yet elegant, flavours of plum, vanilla and chocolate. Aged in French oak barrels for 12 months.
- 45 **Billo Priorat 2010** Spain 14% £29.95
Exclusive to Davy's sourced from the relatively new and exciting region of Priorat in Northern Spain. A blend of Grenache, Syrah, Carignan and Cabernet Sauvignon. Intense ripe dark fruits with notes of herbs and balsamic.
