The Wine Cellar at Tate Britain

While this room was opened to the public in 1927, the origins of our cellar are less clear.

It is likely, that as with many of Britain's old institutions, the Tate had a cellar to entertain donors, patrons and artists.

At some point in the 1970's the 'refreshment room' as it was called, became the Tate Gallery Restaurant. From here the wine list really gained attention.

Renowned for offering classic wines at the best prices, the stories our regulars re-count about what they drank in years gone by and how little they paid leave us green with envy.

In the 1990's Hamish Anderson took charge of the wine program, today he maintains a keen eye and influence in his role as CEO of Tate Catering.

We still buy a lot of wine, to lay down, en-premier especially Burgundy, while we also have strong representation from Italy, Australia and most recently South Africa, holding them until we believe, through a course of knowledge and tasting, they are ready for you to enjoy.

The world of wine is ever changing and the wine list remains a key element of what we do as well as a great passion.

1. CHÂTEAUNEUF DU PAPE

A full bodied Red Rhone wine. Drink only just off cellar temperature. Ideal with game and most main courses.

2. ST. EMILION

Red Bordeaux. A full bodied Claret. Serve at room temperature. At its best with roast red meat.

3. GEVREY CHAMBERTIN

The most celebrated of Red Burgundies. Medium strength. Fine and delicate. Serve slightly warmed with roasts.

4. HAUT SAUTERNES

A great white Bordeaux wine. Soft and sweet. Serve cold with sweet or dessert.

5. GRAVES SEC

A fine potent white Bordeaux with plenty of bouquet. Serve cool. At its best with hors d'oeuvre or grilled fish.

6. CHABLIS

A beautiful pale gold, dry Burgundy of full strength. Serve cool. Ideal with oysters, hors d'oeuvre or grilled fish.

7. POUILLY FUISSÉ

Dry, heady with a fine bouquet. A white Burgundy of distinction. Serve cool. Is perfect with steamed, creamed or boiled fish.

CHAMPAGNE BRUT

Really very dry and with no artificial sweetening added. You can drink it as an aperitif or with everything except cheese and sweet.

SPARKLING

A glass of something fizzy is an ideal apéritif, clearing and refreshing the palate for the meal ahead. However don't overlook its ability to make an excellent and versatile partner to food. Our 'house' sparkling is English from Nyetimber in West Sussex, it is moreish and oozes class. We are just as proud of our long association with Billecart-Salmon and have a fine collection of their Champagne.
