

THE WALBROOK

Situated in the heart of the Square Mile in its own private court and surrounded by the Bloomberg buildings, the Bank of England and the Mansion House, The Walbrook Club opened in May 2000 and was designed by the late Mark Birley of Mark's Club and Annabel's in Mayfair.

Often described as a hidden gem, The Walbrook prides itself on its personal service, absolute discretion and high standards of fine dining it offer to members and non-members to entertain, conduct business and simply relax.

The Club is ideal for holding private and corporate events: presentations, corporate breakfasts, lunches or dinners, receptions, private events including boutique weddings, or other private celebrations. There is the Bar, the Main Dining Room and two smaller private rooms.



THE DINING ROOM

The Dining Room overlooks the garden of the Church of St Stephen. The elegant atmosphere is enhanced by a mixture of amusing objects, contemporary and classics art pieces.

The Victorian olive wood table and chairs mix effortlessly with a painting by the contemporary artist, Ben Johnson, which gives an infinite perspective of the interior of the Cini Foundation in Venice.

THE OAK ROOM

The Oak Room is panelled in pale English oak and is ideal for both meetings and private dining where absolute discretion are required.

Capacity: 10 seated

THE BAR

The beautifully appointed Bar is perfect for pre-dinner drinks.

Capacity: 50 standing

The Walbrook POSTAL address is 37A Walbrook, however it is actually located in Bond Court, off Walbrook.

By Car, turn from Queen Victoria Street into Bucklersbury, where passengers can alight by the Church of St. Stephen Walbrook. Pedestrians should turn left by Starbucks Coffee Shop and the Walbrook Club is directly ahead. Due to redevelopment of this area, there is currently no car parking available in the immediate vicinity.

By Tube, the nearest station is BANK. Leave at Exit 8 onto Walbrook. Opposite the Tube exit on the left, is the Church of St Stephen Walbrook and next door is Starbucks on the corner of Bond Court. Turn left there and directly in front is Queen Anne House that is The Walbrook Club.

CANNON STREET station is at the other end of Walbrook, the Club is reached by walking up Walbrook and turning right at Starbucks Coffee Shop.
