



White wine

Chardonnay II Paradosso Inzolia, 2015 £19.50

Sicily, Italy

Dry white with scents of apricot and honey on the nose, yet surprising on the palate with strong exotic and tropical fruit overtones. A well-structured wine with a crisp acidity and a refreshing finish.

Boatman's Drift Chenin Blanc, 2016 £22

Western Cape, South Africa

Made from 100% Chenin Blanc, this wine is pale lemon in colour with a bouquet of apple and white flowers. The palate is crisp with notes of white peach, mango and guava and a fresh and zesty acidity.

Grenache Blanc La Loupe, 2016 £23

Languedoc, France

A hidden gem from this rarely encountered single varietal. Lovely dry and richly textured palate, it is impressively fragrant with hedgerow flowers and orange blossom. It is a wine made to be enjoyed young and fresh, with a mid-bodied palate rich with flavours of acacia, peach and greengages balanced by a dry mineral finish.

Rueda "Verdejo", Monte Blanco, 2015

Rueda, Spain

It has a bright straw yellow colour with greenish hues, the nose is crisp and fresh with delicate aromas of tropical fruit and hints of fennel and aniseed. A soft mouth feel with citrus and mineral notes leads to a lingering finish on the palate.

Sauvignon Blanc, Wairau River, 2016

£27

Marlborough, New Zealand

Clean and crisp it is bursting with a flinty minerality with flavours of grapefruit, gooseberry, herbs and white stone fruit. Expressive on the palate, finishing with great length.

Riesling, Polish Hill River, 2011

Clare Valley, South Australia

This youthful, aromatic, dry wine has intense mineral and floral aromas on the nose. These aromas follow through on the palate leading to flavours of lime, citrus and white blossom. Tropical fruits and citrus dominate the fresh, racy acidity and a distinct minerality comes through on the palate leaving a fantastic, clean finish.



Sancerre Domaine de la Grande Maison, Chaumeau-Balland, 2015

Loire, France

The nose is mineral, saline, with hints of stone fruit (peaches), white blossoms and a pleasant creaminess. Rich and round on the palate, this wine is refined, mineral and it displays flavours of citrus fruit, lemon peel and spices (white pepper).

Mâcon-Chaintre Serreuxdieres Domaine Dominique Cornin, 2015

Burgundy, France

Pale-medium lemon in colour; an exuberant yet mineral and elegant wine, displaying ripe notes of exotic fruit with silky mouth feel and zesty finish.

Gavi di Gavi Cantine Volpi, 2016

£34

Piedmont, Italy

This dry wine has a perfumed mineral character, with aromas of citrus fruits, peaches and flowers. The fruit character follows through on the palate accompanied by lingering hints of vanilla and a crisp minerality. This soft-textured Gavi has a dry and steely finish.

Pinot Gris 'Reserve' JB Adam, 2014

Alsace, France

This ripe Pinot Gris has a rich concentration of exotic spice, peach and melon on the palate backed by flinty mineral nuances. It is weighty with a smooth and supple mouthfeel, yet this richness is well balanced by a crisp acidity that all combines to create a beautiful wine which lingers on the palate.



Red wine

Nero d'Avola Shiraz II Paradosso, 2015

£19.50

Sicily, Italy

Ruby-red in colour, the bouquet is slightly spicy and fruity with notes of blackberries, blueberries and mulberries. The feel of the wine is incredibly smooth on the palate with a pleasant sensation of ripe black cherries, plums, bramble fruit and slightly chewy tannins lingering on the finish.

Rosario Cabernet Sauvignon, 2015

£22

Valle Central, Chile

Dark ruby colour; aromas of red fruits, berries, dark cherries and cassis mix here with sweet vanilla and coconut notes. This is a medium-bodied wine, ripe yet fresh, with soft tannins and a good, long finish.

Merlot, Domaine St Esteve, 2015

£23

Languedoc, France

Silky, round and ripe, this juicy Merlot is packed full of soft, red fruit and rich plum flavours. This wine is supple enough to drink alone but has plenty of structure to accompany food.

Chamuyo Malbec Mendoza Vineyards, 2016

£25

Mendoza, Argentina

This Malbec is bright cherry red with a violet hue. It shows intense aromas of ripe, red summer fruit, herbs and subtle warm spice. The palate is medium-bodied, rounded yet fresh with soft, supple tannins.

Kirstenbosch Cabernet Sauvignon, 2012

£27

Paarl, South Africa

Smoky, dark, berry fruits blend perfectly with subtle tar and ash characteristics on the finish, giving a true South African flavour. Full and rich, this wine is well-structured with balancing freshness.

Pinot Noir Turning Heads, 2015

£29

Marlborough, New Zealand

The wine is aged in a combination of new and old fine grain French oak for 10 months. This cherry coloured wine has clean fresh fruit aromas on the nose. The palate has ripe red fruit characters of plums, cherries and raspberries along with smoky oak and well integrated, supple tannins. A medium bodied wine with a sustained and elegant finish.



Soraie Cecilia Beretta, 2014

£32

Veneto, Italy

With the grapes dried in the Amarone style, this blend of native varietals as well as Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon is rich and concentrated with red berry fruit, dark chocolate and sweet spices. A great accompaniment to roasted red meats and ragus.

Azabache Rioja Reserva, 2012

£34

Rioja, Spain

Rioja Reserva is made only in the best vintages. This wine is well balanced with a soft seductive character typical of the Tempranillo and Graciano grapes used in the blend. It is aged for at least three years in oak and in bottle before release. Azabache Reserva exhibits intense plummy fruits on the nose with hints of blackberries, mulberries, vanilla, and spice on the soft and well-rounded palate.

Hautes Cotes de Beaune, Domaine du Prieure, 2014

Burgundy, France

This Pinot Noir, from the higher slopes above Savigny, extols the virtues of this tricky grape variety, with a purity of fruit and a captivating perfume of summer berries which finishes to a soft silkiness.

Chateau Tour de Cauze, Grand Cru St Emilion, 2012

Bordeaux, France

This extraordinary wine exhibits very ripe fruit, intense aromas of redcurrant, blackberry and spicy notes. The tannins are silky and combine with a lingering black cherry and coffee finish. It is full bodied and supple on the palate with a gentle touch of oak giving depth and structure.



Champagne & sparkling wine

Prosecco Spumante Extra Dry, Borgo Del Col Alto

Veneto, Italy

This is a pale and delicate wine with a fine mousse and persistent fine bubbles. The clean fruity aromatic bouquet contains hints of flowers, honey and apple leading to a well-balanced, light and fresh palate.

Cremant D'Alsace Brut, Jean Baptiste Adam

£36

Alsace, France

Pale lemon in colour with a delicate mousse, this wine has a highly expressive nose of stone fruits and white flowers. The palate is round with peachy stone fruit flavours balanced perfectly by the fine mousse and zesty citrus acidity, which combine to make this a pleasant and harmonious wine.

Hindleap Classic Cuvee NV Brut, Bluebell Vineyard Estates

East Sussex, England

Fragrant and floral on the nose, the palate has notes of orange zest, citrus, white blossom and fresh green apple. The creamy mousse is well balanced by a crisp and fresh acidity.

Champagne De Malherbe Brut NV

£58

Champagne, France

A soft and well-rounded Champagne that exhibits typical attractive brioche aromas with hints of red fruits and citrus. The extended maturation on the lees gives a supple balance, with a hint of minerality that makes this wine a classic example of regional terroir. Well-structured with a persistent mousse, it is round and full in the mouth, with hints of vanilla and biscuits on the finish.

Laurent-Perrier Brut NV

Champagne, France

Pale gold in colour with a delicate and complex nose, with hints of citrus and white fruits. Fresh and easy on the palate, with full flavours, plenty of fruit, good balance and length



Rosé

La Brouette Rosé, 2015

£21

Comte Tolosan, France

Bright vivid pink in colour with upfront, juicy red fruits on the nose and palate. This is a fresh, round and well balanced rosé with supple tannins and lively acidity.

Sweet wine

Muscat de Beaumes-de-Venise, Domaine de Coyeux (half bottle), 2009

£28

Rhone, France

A delicious sweet wine, rich and grapey with a touch of apricots in the background.

Chateau Briatte (half bottle), 2011

£34

Sauternes, France

Lemon gold in colour, this shimmers in the glass – enticing. The palate combines honeyed orchard fruit with citrus refreshment, all complemented by a briny mineral layer.
