



One of the oldest pubs in London, The Footman has been in place since 1749.

Originally called the Running Horse it was frequented by the footmen who were in service to the households of Mayfair.

They would run ahead of their masters' coaches, paying any tolls in advance and clearing a safe passage ahead. As the fashion for footmen eventually dwindled, one bought the pub and named it after himself. Often the source of the best gossip, the pub soon became well known.

Formally known as The Only Running Footman we are a three floored pub & dining room still catering for the people of Mayfair and beyond. Traditionally bedecked but with modern stylings, we offer food from our exciting menu from midday Monday to Saturday and also open early for coffee, drinks and business in relaxed surroundings.

Rioja Crianza, Urbina Selección, *Spain, 1999* 50.00

This old school Rioja is remarkably aromatic with nicely knit tannins, fruitiness and a long finish. A blend of tempranillo, Mazuelo & Graziano it's perfect with lamb dishes.

Condrieu, Domaine du Monteillet, *France, 2016* 61.50

Pale, straw coloured Viognier with lovely Spring aromas of peach, apricot & violet. This lengthy full bodied wine is great with lobster, poultry & goats curd.

Pauillac, Chateau Batailley Grand Cru, *Bordeaux, France 2007* 78.00

Named after a 'bataille' between the English & French 600 years ago, this Pauillac marries' ripe plum and cedar into vivid raspberry and vanilla with a lovely long finish.

Hermitage, Marquise de la Tourette Rouge, *Rhone, France 1998* 120.00

This rich Syrah based red from the Cotes de Rhone offers amazing structure and body.

St. Emilion, Chateau Larcis Ducasse Grand Cru, *Bordeaux France, 2009* 140.00

This Grand Cru has a soft approach but is filled with great depth & flavours of ripe plum, blackberries & blackcurrant. A really lovely, elegant wine, great with beef or game.

Pauillac, Chateau Pontet- Canet, *Bordeaux, France, 2007* 215.00

An amazing wine with pure black fruit on the nose, lots of ripe tannins and a mouth- watering finish, packed full of coffee, cedar & tobacco. A special wine.
