White Wine

Light & Crisp

Sanziana Pinot Grigio, Banat 2018 (Romania) £14.95

This has opulent aromas of grapefruit and peach, with fresh flavours of melon, apple and zesty citrus.

Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine de Morin Langaran 14/15 (France) £16.95

This wine is both gentle and refreshing with notes of Mediterranean white peach, apricot kernel and zesty lime peel culminating in a silky mouth-feel and crisp, vibrant acidity.

Quincy Une Promesse, Domaine de l'Epine 2017 (France) £21.00

This has an intense nose of exotic fruits and pear, it is ripe, fresh and creamy on the palate, with aromatic persistence.

Mont de Joie Sauvignon Blanc 2014 (France) £16.95

Delicious, zesty Sauvignon from vineyards close to Sancerre, made by the region's star performer: Henri Bourgeois.

Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons, Domaine Vincent Dampt 2014 (France) £33.00

The nose shows pure citrus and orchard fruits. The palate has crushed sea-shell minerality and a rich creaminess.

Fresh & Aromatic

La Muse de Cabestany Chardonnay Viognier 2018 (France) £17.95

From one of the oldest wineries in the Minervois region, comes this Chardonnay-Viognier blend, boasting a trademark freshness with orange blossom notes and ripe, orchard fruit flavours.

Andaina Godello Adegas Galegas 2017 (Spain) £18.50

This displays a slightly weighty texture, refreshing minerality and aromas of wild flowers and chamomile.

Thanisch Estate Riesling Kabinett, Weingut Dr H Thanisch 2016 (Germany) £26.00

Vibrant, zesty and bright, offering a fragrant array of Asian pear, apple and lychee, laced with icing sugar.

Ripe & Fruity

Sauvignon Blanc, Elephant Hill 2016 (New Zealand) £22.00
Delicate aromas of citrus, gooseberry and fresh herbs. The palate shows juicy green apple, citrus and white peach flavours, refreshing minerality and a round texture from the time spent on lees.

Rosé Wine

Light & Delicate

Sanziana Pinot Grigio Rosé 2018 (Romania) £14.95
Gently floral, with red berry flavours and a touch of sweet spice.

Pétale de Rose, Château La Tour de L'Éveque Rosé 2014/15 (France) £27.00
Delicate aromas of white blossom, rose petals and strawberry on the nose. Subtle on the palate, this wine displays ripe red fruits and crisp minerality over a luscious creamy texture, culminating in a clean, refreshing finish.

Red Wine

Fruity & Smooth

Sanziana Merlot 2018 (Romania) £14.95
Spiced plums and violets on the nose, with a soft and silky palate of juicy red cherries, raspberries and toasted notes.

Rheingau Spatburgunder, Schloss Schonborn 2013 (Germany) £19.95
Here we find fragrant, floral, berried fruit underscored by crushed stone minerals.

Fleurie Grand-Pré, Domaine Lathuilière Gravallon 2014 (France) £21.95
This Fleurie displays sweet red gamay fruit, as well as an impressive finesse and body drawn from its pink granite soils.

Rich & Spicy

Côtes du Rhône, Vignobles Gonnet 2013 (France) £17.95
This Côtes du Rhone is exceptional for its elegance and structure, exuding all the violet, dried herb and spicy dark fruit for which the appellation is famous.

Salterio Mencía Adegas Galegas 2017 (Spain) £18.50
Dense with a rounded texture, Salterio displays concentrated flavours of sweet and savoury cherry, complimented by light floral notes with a spicy touch.

Perfumed & Elegant

Sanziana Pinot Noir 2018 (Romania) £15.50
This has layers of complex black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon with pretty fruit cake and deep spicy notes.

La Muse de Cabestany Pinot Noir 2017 (France) £17.95
This elegant Pinot displays hints of rose petal, liquorice and a fresh, lingering finish.

Pinot Noir Elephant Hill 2017 (New Zealand) £30.00
Fruit forward and bright with beautiful soft tannin, this wine has ripe berry fruit density and subtle floral notes followed by bay leaf and spice.

Sparkling Wine

Sylvoz, Prosecco Le Colture Brut NV (Italy) £22.00
Le Colture, based in Valdobbiadene, are true sparkling wine experts. Over 500 years of experience have led this old-established family to produce a world class Prosecco: light and delicate, with notes of orchard fruit and white flowers.

Sparkling Rosé Le Colture Brut NV (Italy) £22.00
This hand-made sparkling rosé wine is the perfect party pink! It has a lovely, delicate mousse and ripe, red berry flavours.

Ambriel Rosé Extra Dry 2013 (England) £36.00
A delicate rose-petal colour, the wine wraps subtle wild strawberry and ripe redcurrant characters in refined bubbles, lifted by a crisp apple, succulent finish.

Ambriel Classic Cuvée Brut NV (England) £38.00
This is an elegant English sparkling wine, bright and fine, with ripe cox apple and pear flavours, creamy summer berries and notes of brioche.

Champagne

Delamotte Brut NV (France) £46.00
One of the oldest houses, Delamotte's champagnes remains hand crafted. The high proportion of Grand Cru Chardonnay gives this non-vintage blend a lovely balance of fresh, well-rounded, rich fruit and floral notes. A clean, crisp vibrancy finishes a beautiful wine.

Delamotte Rosé Brut NV (France) £65.00
Champagne Delamotte's Rosé is a blend of 80% Pinot Noir and 20% Chardonnay from Grand Cru vineyards. Delamotte still produces its rosé by the 'saignée' method, a highly-skilled technique employed by a few discerning Champagne houses. Delamotte Rosé is all elegance and finesse with appealing wild strawberry fruit.

Laurent-Perrier La Cuvee Brut NV (France) £65.00
La Cuvee is Laurent-Perrier's signature champagne, so called as it is crafted using the purest grape juice obtained during the gentle first pressing. La Cuvee defines the House style and serves as an ideal introduction to our wines with its characteristic lightness, freshness and elegance.

Veuve Clicquot Brut NV (France)

£78.00

With its radiant style Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label gives the thrill of a vibrant life full of elegance and audacity. Grapes from as many as 50 to 60 different Crus go into the blend of Yellow Label. The Chef de Caves has to achieve the total consistency of taste, which makes Yellow Label so immediately recognizable, so utterly reliable in terms of quality, colour and bouquet.

Sweet Wine & Port

Château Septy 2011 Halves (France)

£14.50

Here we have a delectable nose, rich in a combination of exotic and citrus fruit, with honeyed notes. The palate is richly-textured yet has a vibrant flash of zest which gives focus and direction.

Corney & Barrow Ruby Port (Portugal)

£21.00

Matured for three years in seasoned oak. A serious ruby port, intensely coloured, rich and peppery.
