

## Sparkling

### **Pupitre, Cava Traditional Brut N.V, Penedes, Spain 45**

Named after the classic racks used to age sparkling wine, Pupitre captures the slow, complex essence of traditional Cava making, offering aromas of acacia, apple, and aniseed with bright lemon notes, fine mousse, and a long, refreshing finish.

### **Masia Salat, Organic Rose Cava, Brut N.V, Penedes, Spain 45.5**

An organic Cava with lovely balance of varietal aromas such as raspberries, figs and delicate floral notes. Very fresh and light with a good balance between the acidity and the fruit concentration and a smooth creamy mousse at the finish.

### **Prosecco Treviso Spumante Brut Il Follo, Veneto, Italy 49**

Bright fresh and zippy with rich citrus, peach and white flowers. The palate has nice intensity with notes of apple, lemon and peach fruit. A crisp and lively wine with decent mousse and good length.

### **Fossile Brut, Fleury-la-Rivière Champagne M&G Heucq, Champagne, France 89**

This NV Brut Fossile has really expressive fruit! Is packed with apple and grapefruit, showing ripeness and precision. Frothy, lively, foamy mousse defines the palate and disperses a light-bodied, fresh wine with ripe notes of juicy Mirabelle.

## White

### **Naturete, Organic Verdejo 2024, Bodegas Parra Jimenez, La Mancha, Spain 34**

A lovely, organic Verdejo with aromas of lemon, lime flesh and white peach. Beautifully crisp and dry on the palate, a fine citrus flavour and intriguing minerality gives way to a clean and refreshing finish.

### **Amoterra 2024 Trebbiano d'Abruzzo, Abruzzo, Italy 39.5**

Light and refreshing organic wine, full of floral aromas and vibrant flavours of apple, pear and some citrus. Amoterra means "to love the land" and the ethos behind this organically made wine serves to protect the environment from where it is made.

### **Vinho Verde 2024, Espigueiro Casa Agricola de Compostela, Portugal, Minh 40**

This breezy Vinho Verde is apple and fresh with a delicious citrus spritz. Lighter-bodied but not lacking in flavour and depth will make a perfect aperitif that goes down far too easily!

### **Soave Mito 2025, Monte Tondo, Veneto, Italy 40**

This Soave Mito by Monte Tondo in Veneto has a delicate nose with hints of almonds, blossoms and citrus. Clean fruit flavors with nicely balanced acidity and the typical Soave minerality.

### **Picpoul De Pinet 2024, Rocs Blancs, Languedoc, France 43**

Golden yellow with aromas of fresh peach and a hint of hazelnut, this wine gains depth from old vines, revealing white fruit and elegant minerality on a long, refined finish.

### **Organic Gewürztraminer 2024, Paraiso Sur, Vinedos Emiliana, Chile 44**

The tropical fruit flavours shine through excellently with this wine. The nose offers floral aromas of jasmine and rose petals, lychee, herbs and notes of honey. Complemented by apple, apricot and mandarin orange, this has a persistent sweet and fruity finish.

### **Grüner Veltliner 2024, Besas, Traisental, Austria 44.5**

The Besas Grüner Veltliner is a racy, spicy Austrian wine with aromas of white pepper, peach, and pear, and a fresh, fruit-driven palate of lime, nectarine, and spice leading to a zesty finish.

### **Albariño 2025, Pazo Mirasoles, Bodegas Parra Jimenez, La Mancha, Spain 44.5**

Clean, bright yellow colour with Golden highlights. Citric hints on the nose, floral notes with an elegant herbal background. Fresh in the mouth with a good volume and citric finish. Great as an aperitif, even better with fish or shellfish.

- La Cepa de Pelayo 2024, Organic Macabeo, Ole de Passion, Manchuela, Spain, 45**  
A pale-yellow wine, perfectly clean and bright. Aromatic with clear varietal notes of citrus, white flowers and a background of freshly cut grass. The palate is fresh and bright with citrus acidity, ripe white fruit and hints of bakery. Very pleasant with a good persistence and length.
- Gavi 2024, Folli & Benato, Piedmont, Italy 46**  
In this Gavi, white peach, lemon balm and white blossom notes greet the nose. The palate is riper than you might expect with juicy pear and green apple notes. All of this is brought together by a lifting freshness in the finish that pulls you in to taste more.
- Viogner 2024, Domaine les Yeuses, Languedoc-Roussillon, France 46**  
A delicious Viognier, nothing is overdone, freshness is key. Some delightful aromatics including wildflowers, apricot and honey, then on the palate, good texture, balanced fresh stone fruit, nectarine and apricot and a gentle creaminess to the finish.
- Wairau River Estate, Sauvignon Blanc 2024, Marlborough, New Zealand 46.5**  
Intense aromas of ripe tropical fruit and citrus lead to a refined, textured palate of guava and stone fruit, finishing fresh, dry, and long. A benchmark New World Sauvignon, cool-fermented in stainless steel to preserve its vibrant fruit character.
- Chenin Blanc 'Harmonie' 2023, Complices de Loire, Loire, France 46.5**  
This is a delightful, smooth-textured wine with a lovely balance that threads the needle between a fruit driven style and a more savoury style. Flavours and aromas of green apple, ripe pear and honeysuckle, followed by a waxy texture and poached spiced apple, and a lovely crisp acidity.
- Chardonnay 2024, Bon Vallon, De Wetshof Estate, Robertson, South Africa 47.5**  
Pioneered by Danie de Wet, this fresh, unwooded Chardonnay reveals delicate aromas of lemon, honeysuckle, and peach, with vibrant, lemony flavours on the palate and a subtle yeasty, nutty finish from lees ageing.
- Xaxaxa Organic 2023, Can Valles, Penedes, Spain 50.5**  
This easy drinking white is made of a blend of Xarel-lo & Chardonnay combining fresh bright fruit and texture. Notes of fresh citrus, pear and apple on the nose, and a silky velvety texture to complement the lively acidity and fresh flavours. This wine certainly doesn't tire as its sensational moreish character means you can enjoy alone or with food.
- Rueda Verdejo Blanco 2024, Marques de Riscal, Rueda, Spain 52**  
Made from 100% organic Verdejo from Marqués de Riscal's Rueda vineyards, showing aromas of aniseed and fennel. Fresh and mineral-driven on the palate, with good structure, length, and a clear reflection of the Rueda terroir.
- Pinot Grigio 2024, Russolo, Ronco Calaj, Friuli-Venezia, Italy 53**  
This small production PG from the Russolo family has poise, elegance, and a fruit expression that'll have you turning your head. Pear, lime zest, and white peach notes flanked by dusty chalk, dried green herbs and a zingy, refreshing finish.
- Little Ark Malagousia-Assyrtiko 2024, Lantides Estate, Peloponnese, Greece 55**  
Brilliant straw colour with greenish shades. On the nose the wine shows expressive notes of exotic fruit and notes of melon, lemon, green pepper and jasmine with orange. The mouth is delightfully rich with flavours of peach and green apple and a lemony fresh finish that lingers and evolves.
- Estelle Blanc 2024, Domaine Terres Destel, Provence, France 56**  
A fine, complex wine with aromas of ripe fruit, almond and honey. On the palate, this Vermentino remains highly aromatic and generous, with a mineral finish.
- Chardonnay 2024, Domaine de la Pierre des Dames, Bourgogne, France 56**  
The nose opens with enticing aromas of lime blossom and tropical fruit, especially ripe mango, creating a vibrant bouquet. On the palate, it's full-bodied and lushious, with a beautifully long, fresh finish.

- Godello MG 2024, Pazo da Maga, Ribeira Sacra, Spain** 58  
This Godello seems to go from strength to strength. Gorgeously textured, but never too weighty, so bright and fresh -is a delight. Pithy lime and a firm white peachiness are beautifully balanced by a crisp mineral streak. Delicious on its own or with fresh seafood.
- Hacienda El Tenero Blanco, Seleccion Especial 2024, Rioja Alta, Spain** 58.5  
This fantastic viura from Hacienda el Ternero has an abundance of apricots and ripe apple notes on the nose. The palate is rich with tropical fruits, honeysuckles, pink lady apples, almonds and a creamy note from the well-integrated oak influence. One of our favourites!
- Gulfi 2023, Valcanzjria, Sicily, Italy** 58.5  
Fruity, floral, and textured, with a lovely layer of complexity. Chamomile, jasmine and lemon notes are joined by warming dough and white peach. Chardonnay and carricante, this is incredibly balanced with a lovely mouthfeel. This organic certified Sicilian will bring a smile to your face!
- Albariño Eidos De Padrinan 2024, Adegas dos Eidos, Rias Baixas, Spain** 66  
Beautifully textured and deliciously tangy, this is such a brilliant version of one of Spain's most famous white varieties. White flowers, mediterranean herbs, citrus and peach abound, the palate has lovely weight with a gentle saltiness on the long finish.
- Txakoli, Hika, 2022, Getariako Txakolina, Basque Country, Spain** 66  
This white Txakoli is fresh and bright, with lemon hues, citrus aromas, and subtle herbaceous notes. The palate is lightly spritzzy with crisp acidity, citrus and white fruit flavors, and a clean, mineral finish.
- Gran Autòcton Blanc 2021, Autòcton Celler, Catalunya, Spain** 72  
A distinguished blend of Xarel.lo and Malvasia. It displays a deep golden hue and offers aromas of ripe stone fruits, honey and toasted almonds. On the palate, it unfolds with full-bodied texture, showcasing layers of peach, apricot and a subtle touch of vanilla.
- 'Les Belles Filles' 2020, Penard-Vergelesses, Maison Patriarche, Burgundy, France** 76  
An expressive and elegant chardonnay, with aromas of white flowers and citrus zest. Slightly saline texture and very refreshing.
- Assyrtiko 2023, Abyss, Lantides Estate, Peloponnesse, Greece** 78  
The estate's flagship cuvée, made from 100% Assyrtiko, shines with a bright straw hue and aromas of passion fruit, honeysuckle, and a hint of smoke. The palate offers fresh citrus, a smooth, rounded body, and a richly complex texture leading to an elegant finish. Simply delicious!
- Chardonnay 2022, Land of Saints, Santa Barbara, USA** 80  
This Chardonnay is reminiscent of a Meursault. Classic hints of lemon, lemon curd, baking spice with a hint of vanilla. Aged in 30% new French barriques there is a perfectly balanced textural tone throughout the wine, with plenty of mineral cut to back it up.
- Chardonnay L'Envol 2018, Domaine Auvigue, Pouilly Fuise, Burgundy, France** 92  
Bright citrus and lush tropical fruit weave through the subtle toast and spice, tapering into a gently bitter finish.
- Sancerre 2024, Domaine Vincent Delaporte, Loire, France** 96  
Very expressive, intense, and complex nose with boxwood, rhubarb, blackcurrant, kiwi fragrances, and light vegetal touch. Bright freshness on the palate, delicate and lively purity. Well balanced and harmonious, it ends with a clean lingering finish.
- Saint Véran 2020, Les Pommards, Domaine Barraud, Burgundy, France** 100  
This wine has a pretty bouquet with yellow plum, honeysuckle and light almond scents, all very well defined. The palate starts with quite an edgy, stem ginger-tinged opening and segues into a pithy mid-palate. This is more a textural Mâconnais and makes it a more interesting Saint-Véran than many.
- Chailoux 1er Cru 2022, Domaine Auvigue, Pouilly Fuise, Burgundy, France** 100  
Subtle nose of creamy oatmeal, while round and lemony, pithy bright palate. The body has rich fruit but balanced and fresh. A gorgeous example of Bourgogne chardonnay.

## Orange

**Ancestralopitekus Organic 2024, Bodegas Parra Jimenez, La Mancha, Spain** 44.5  
Made from biodynamically farmed Verdejo grapes, this orange wine from La Mancha is a great entry into the world of orange wine. The wine is only partially filtered and has an attractive cloudy amber colour. Subtle vanilla and spice along with delicate aromas of peach and orange are complimented by savoury, peppery notes, making it a smooth and complex wine.

## Rose

**Mezzogiorno Rosato 2024, Puglia, Italy** 31  
This lightly coloured rosé is a classic example from the south of Italy. Red fruit and berries, apples and melon and an intriguing underlying green herbal note. Fresh, vibrant fruit flavours provide texture and weight supported by bright, balancing acidity.

**Mantina Rose Moschofilero 2024, Moropoulos winery, Arcadia, Greece** 44  
Attractive pale pink colour. On the nose very aromatic with pure red fruit, crunchy cherries and raspberries along with creme patisserie nuances. On the palate is lively with punchy fruit and a hint of acid providing intensity and lift. Perfect for summer drinking.

**Le Poussin Rose 2024, Languedoc, France** 46  
Le Poussin is a delicate, pale pink rosé from the sandy vineyards on the Mediterranean coast where the Languedoc meets Provence. The nose has floral, rose petal scents with a hint of strawberry followed by a dry, well-balanced palate of supple summer fruits.

## Red

**Malbec 2022, Bodega Privada, Mendoza, Argentina** 36  
A smooth, elegant wine with aromas of black cherry, plum, and blueberry, mid-body red and black fruit flavors, soft tannins, and a clean, mineral finish.

**Garnacha 2024, Bodegas y Viñedos Monfil, Cariñena, Spain** 39  
Loaded with exuberant blueberry, cranberry and damson fruit. Supple and fresh in the mouth with succulent berry fruitiness and a delicate bite of tannin. Bright, appetising and easy going with real interest.

**Amoterra 2024, Montepuciano d'Abruzzo, Abruzzo, Italy** 39.5  
From Organic certified vineyards, this is a vibrant and fruit-forward Montepulciano from Amoterra, with juicy berry fruit character and great concentration. Fresh and easy drinking with a deliciously smooth finish.

**Vega Tinto 2020, Duoro Valley, DFJ Vinhos, Douro, Portugal** 40.5  
Rich and full bodied but very smooth in the mouth with plum, cherry and mineral elements and complex with a firm grip of tannins, typical of the region.

**Organic Pinot Noir 2023, Paraiso Sur, Vinedos Emiliana, Limari Valley, Chile.** 41.5  
This Chilean Pinot Noir made from grapes which have benefited from the organic and sustainable farming practices used, shows a vibrant, fruity expression of the variety. Aromas of berries, sweet vanilla and soft floral notes gives way to a fruity palate, velvety texture and an intense finish.

**La Petite Syrah 2024, Domaine les Yeuses, Languedoc – Roussillon, France** 42  
Dark fruit, with blackberry and damson notes, not too sweet with just enough savour, soft and silky on the palate. Seriously impressive and remarkably refined this wine is well judged and fun to drink!

**Tranquille Pinard 2024, Les Vignerons De Castelas, Southern Rhone, France** 47  
Named after the French term for the soldiers' morale-boosting wine, this Grenache-led blend is soft and convivial, with aromas of raspberry and cherry. After five weeks of skin contact and ageing in concrete, it shows fresh red fruit, gentle Rhône spice, smooth tannins, and balanced acidity.

- Primitivo 2024, Salento Cantine de Falco, Puglia, Italy** 47  
This a cracking example of Primitivo. Bright and perky this has a fine zippy line that makes it not only food friendly but very moreish. Cherry skin and cooked damson and delightful drop from the sunny heel of Italy.
- Rioja Reserva 2019, Azabache, Rioja Oriental, Spain** 48  
Well balanced with a soft seductive character typical of the Tempranillo and Graciano grapes used in the blend. It exhibits a soft and well-rounded palate but with powerful, smooth tannins for impressive structure. Intense plummy fruits on the nose with flavours of blackberries, mulberries, black cherries, vanilla and spice that linger on the finish.
- La Pinada 2021, Bobal, Agricola de Vinos la Higuera, Valencia, Spain** 48  
With a fresh and fruit-forward nose, the wine displays aromas of blackberry, dark cherry, blossom, and a hint of earthy minerality. On the palate it is juicy, focused and well balanced, with a crunchy acidity and some light drying tannins.
- Salcheto 2024, Chianti Biskero, Toscana, Italy** 48  
This organic Chianti spends little time in oak, unlike many of its Tuscan siblings. This gives the Sangiovese grape the chance to express its pure red cherry and plum character and add a delicately spiced finish. A smooth, ripe and fresh wine!
- Zweigelt 2023, `Wagramer Selektion` Heiderer-Mayer, Niederosterreich, Austria** 49  
The grapes of this excellent wine originate from the Wagram wine growing area. The wine is aged for 18 months in large, old oak barrels which adds texture and weight to the mouthfeel. Dark ruby red with violet tones, blackberry and sour cherry notes with velvety tannins.
- SGM 2017, Geoff Merrill, McLaren Vale, Australia** 50  
A classic Rhône-style blend of Shiraz, Grenache, and Mourvèdre, offering aromas of coffee, spice, and fennel. The palate shows raspberries, black cherries, and blackcurrant with earthy savoury notes, supported by fine tannins and well-integrated oak for added complexity.
- Rioja Crianza 2022, Arienzo, Marques de Riscal, Rioja, Spain** 53.5  
A fresh, fruity wine with a lovely concentration, bursting with red berries and plums, complemented by vanilla and sweet spices from the oak. Made from carefully selected grapes; tempranillo, mazuelo and graciano, from some of Marques de Riscals best vineyards. Full and supple with a long finish.
- Viernes, Organic Mencia 2021, Bodegas Godelia, Bierzo, Spain** 54.5  
Made from Godelia's youngest plots of 30-year-old vines. This unoaked Mencia has a youthful and fun character and is a great introduction to the variety. Intense floral and wild berry aromas, this is an elegant wine with soft textured tannins and a long mineral finish.
- Beaujolais - Villages 2023, Domaine Rochette, Beaujolais, France** 56  
This Beaujolais-villages is stacked with blueberry, pomegranate and cranberry fruit, there is lovely generosity on the palate, with nice sappy tannins and a crunch of ripe acidity. Easy-drinking but very more-ish.
- Hito 2024, Bodegas Cepa 21, Ribera del Duero, Spain** 60  
An excellent wine from Ribera del Duero demonstrates the classically powerful style of Tempranillo. The nose is expressive with the varietal aromas of blackberry and blackcurrant with light floral hints and subtle oak character of toast and vanilla. It has great balance and structure with rich fine tannins to balance the vibrant fruit. It pairs well with cold starters, salads, charcuterie or cheese.
- Sierra de Toloño 2023, Rioja Alavesa, Rioja, Spain** 63  
Edgy and very modern in a good way, this Rioja has great freshness and precision. Fragrant and detailed, with damson, blueberry and dark cherry fruit, with a floral push of violets and just a hint of delicate aromatic spice. A beautiful & utterly drinkable wine.
- Taralas Estate, Xinomavro 2020, Naousa, Greece** 63  
A perfumed nose of raspberry, rose petals, black pepper, game and spices with a hint of typical sun-dried tomato notes. Medium-bodied with fresh acidity, and compact ripe yet grippy tannins. Great length, complexity and character for the price.

- Rioja Reserva 2014, Bodegas Ruconia, Rioja, Spain** 65  
This really is a superb traditional Rioja! Licorice, coffee, meat juices, leather, redcurrants, herbs and cedar. And the palate delivers everything in such a balanced style that it is a pure joy from first sip to last. Dangerously drinkable!
- Valpolicella Ripasso 2023, Gorgo, Veneto, Italy** 68  
Ripasso is created by re-fermenting Valpolicella on the dried Amarone grape skins, intensifying its richness and depth. The result is a well-structured wine with notes of black cherry, chocolate, vanilla, pepper, and raisined fruit, velvety smooth with a long, elegant finish.
- Hacienda el Ternero 2018, Seleccion Crianza, Rioja Alta, Spain** 68.5  
Made from 100% Tempranillo, this limited-edition Crianza spends 14 months in French oak barrels. A deep ruby colour with notes of violets and fresh herbs on the nose. The palate is soft with black cherries and plums combined with balsamic, licorice, black olive and toast. A fresh acidity perfectly balances this concentrated and complex wine.
- Pinot Noir 2022, Land of Saints, California, USA** 80  
The wine is notably pinoté on the palate, with bramble and forest floor notes that can only be Pinot Noir, but with a rich New World-ness to it. There's a great line of refreshing acidity running through, making you want to go for another sip.
- Allees De Cantermerle 2019, Haut Medoc, Bordeaux, France** 87.5  
Les Allées de Cantemerle, the second wine of 5th growth Château Cantemerle, shows deep ruby hues with black cherry, cassis, and pencil shavings on the nose. The medium-bodied palate is rounded and soft, with red and black fruits, sweet spices, and supple, ripe tannins.
- Cerasinus Cornas 2022 Bio, Domaine Chapoutier, Rhone Valley, France** 95  
Very dark, this 100% Syrah has a complex nose with notes of wild, ripe black fruit. This is followed by notes of graphite, carbon and soot. On the palate fine tannins and a lovely mineral tension. Full on the palate, with structure. This is an elegant, powerful Cornas with a great deal of balance and finesse.
- Zinfandel, M2 2018, Soucie Vineyard, Lodi, California, USA** 95  
Grown on old vines, this quietly complex wine goes deep into subtle blackberry, fig and coffee flavours, while rich, fine-grained tannins add just enough structure for good balance. Nicely integrated hints of vanilla, cinnamon and mocha come out with more sipping, and the finish lingers.
- Camino de Santa Cruz 2021, Sierra de Toloño, Rioja, Spain** 110  
A modern style Rioja, with character, elegance and stony elements. On the nose blackberries, black cherries, cinnamon, coffee and a hint of smoke. Relatively viscous and strong, but with fine tannins, firm acidity and lots of freshness. Deliciously indulgent!
- Eminence 2023, Domaine Remi Niero, Cote Rotie, Rhone Valley, France** 112  
95 % Syrah and 5% Viognier, this wine has ripe, concentrated fruit flavours. Aromas of blackberries, dark cherries, licorice, and a hint of black pepper compliment floral notes. It offers a velvety texture with a lingering finish.
- XR Special Release Reserva 2021, Marques de Riscal, Rioja, Spain** 115  
Intense black-cherry colour. Very expressive aromas of licorice, cinnamon and black pepper, ripe blueberries and blackcurrants with balsamic notes and just a subtle hint of the long cask-ageing. Good backbone and lovely, polished tannins leading to a long, persistent finish.
- Saint-Joseph 2022, Terres Neuves Domaine Lionnet, Rhone, France** 120  
Made from 100% Syrah, Saint-Joseph is refined and elegant. Delicate and voluptuous, it develops subtle aromas of blackcurrant and raspberry, with hints of leather and licorice. Fresh yet with considerable density.
- Barolo 2021, Vigneto Albarella Andrea Oberto, Piedmont, Italy** 140  
Gorgeously rich and opulent - but with good balance and lively fruit. Dark cherry, plum, spice, leather and dried rose petal build nicely in the glass. Floral accents give brightness throughout. Well-tamed and totally charming.

## Dessert Wines

(75ml glass)

### Les Pins 2024, Monbazillac, Château Tirecul la Gravière, France

9

Fragrant and enticing with ripe peach, citrus, honey and white flowers. With every sip you get a gentle orangey citrus intensity, then dried stone fruits, sultanas and creamy honey, all underpinned by a mouthwatering acidity giving lift and balance.

### Les Carmes De Rieussec 2021, Sauternes, Château Rieussec, Bordeaux, France

10.5

This is a lovely, powerful wine with an almost roasted nut aroma, great elegance and concentration, with a hint of apricots and citrus on the finish and wonderful balance of sweetness and acidity. It makes an excellent choice for wine enthusiasts looking for a quality sweet white wine.

### Niepoort Tawny Dee, Douro, Portugal

8

Brick red/tawny in colour, with delicate nutty aromas and a hint of dried fruits. On the palate, very well balanced with a youthful fruity, luscious character, which integrates well with a long spirity finish.

## Sherry

(75ml glass)

### Inocente Fino Valdespino, Jerez, Spain

8

This Fino has a lifted, sharp nose with almond notes and a hint of 'flor'. On the palate is truly superb and delicious dry, with delicate fresh flavours. Light and engaging, with a clean freshness leaving a pleasant persistence on the finish.

### Tio Diego Dry Amontillado Valdespino, Jerez, Spain

It has a beautiful, perfumed nose of dry flowers, very elegant and clean, with some saline notes, both in the nose and the palate. Balanced, medium-bodied and elegant. A very fine Amontillado, showing superb value for a 15-year-old wine.

### Don Gonzalo Dry Oloroso VOS Valdespino, Jerez, Spain

15

This is a very serious Oloroso, even if it's not totally dry. It offers bitter almonds, hazelnuts, Cuban cigar ash, and dark chocolate as well as a complex, very intense, round and ample palate. This wine really fills your mouth. Very intense and with great acidity, it represents very good value for the quality it delivers.
